- 1 Esaki Lighthouse** A limestone lighthouse located on the northernmost tip of Awaji Island.
- 2 Awaji Highway Rest Area (Matsuhio Anchorage Park)** (Tel: 0799-72-0001) A viewing point for the nearby Akashi Kaikyo Bridge. Highway and Tourist information is available, local products are on sale, there are restaurant facilities and also an Akashi Kaikyo Bridge themed outdoor area.
- 3 View Matsuhio no Sato**(Tel:0799-73-2333) Take a hot spring bath while enjoying the view of the Akashi Kaikyo Bridge. There is a mini golf course next to the hot springs.
- 4 Eshima Island** A small sandstone island with beautiful striped rock patterns.
- 5 Awaji Highway Oasis** (Tel:0799-72-0220) Park facilities directly connected to the Awaji Service Area where you can view many beautiful flowers (Flower Valley). In addition, there is a local specialty shop and restaurant facilities.
- 6 Awaji Island Pref. Park** (Tel:0799-72-5377) From the park lookout, there is a beautiful view of the Harimanada sea and Kitan Strait. You can also enjoy some outdoor activities with the family.
- 7 Tai Odoru Yakata Hall** (Tel:0799-73-2300) Observe the manufacturing process of 'kama-boko' and 'chikwari', fish cakes, made from fresh, locally caught seafood.
- 8 Awaji Island Akashi Kaikyo National Government Park** (Tel:0799-72-2000) Enjoy seasonal flowers at this nationally run park. The tulips in spring are especially famous, the highest ranked in the entire Kansai region.
- 9 Awaji Yumebutai Greenhouse**(Tel:0799-74-1200) Yumebutai Greenhouse is Japan's largest and most beautiful botanical house.
- 10 Awaji Yumebutai** (Tel:0799-74-1000) Includes a conservatory, hotel, restaurant, shops, and an International Conference hall integrated and designed by world famous architect Tadao Ando.
- 11 Awaji Hanasajiki** (Flower Galleries) (Tel:0799-74-6426) Flower gardens spread over approximately 15 hectares.
- 12 Hompukuiji Temple** (Tel:0799-74-3624) The main hall of the temple was designed by world famous architect Tadao Ando, and the roof forms a real lotus pond.
- 13 Higashura Sun Park** (Higashura Flower Hot Springs) (Tel:0799-74-5800) A healing hot

### The Seven Gods of Good Fortune

Temple visitors can purge bad luck, pray for happiness, and also attain a feeling of peace from the popular temple sermons.

- 14 Hokudan Earthquake Memorial Park** (Tel:0799-82-3020) An exhibition and information commemorating the Great Hanshin-Awaji Earthquake. There is also an 'earthquake room' where you can experience an M7 earthquake (7 is the highest on the Japanese earthquake scale).
- 15 The Awaji City Hokudan History and Folk Exhibition Center** (Tel:0799-82-2177) Exhibiting some 3500 items of historical documentation of Hokudan area of Awaji City.
- 16 Asano Park** Famous for its autumn colors and spring cherry blossoms, the park also has a Fudo waterfall.
- 17 Myoshoji Temple and Tsuki no Yama** A temple connected to Ashikaga Takeuji (a famous historical figure). Behind the temple is the 416-meter 'Tsuki no Yama (Moon Mountain)'.
- 18 Joryuji Temple and Ise Forest Set** amongst approx. 300 meter hills, the Ise forest covers a 516-meter peak upon which the Joryuji Temple sits.
- 19 Tozanji Temple** (Tel:0799-64-1185) Established by the famous monk Kobo Daishi.
- 20 Ichinomiya Awaji Castle** (Tel:0799-85-0905) A graceful three-tier castle tower surrounded by an art gallery.
- 21 Parchez Kaori no Yakata and Kaori no Yu** (Fragrant House and Hot Springs) (Tel:0799-85-1162) A perfume making and herb-experience' attraction. There are also aromatic herbal hot springs adjoining.
- 22 Kunjudo** (Tel:0799-85-1301) An incense factory where you can view incense making, or make it by yourself.
- 23 Izanagi Shrine** (Tel:0799-80-5001) According to Japanese legend, this is known as the oldest shrine in the country. The shrine has been respectfully called 'Ikku-sari' since ancient times. Within the compound are two 900 year old camphor trees called the husband and wife, designated by the prefecture as natural monuments.
- 24 Pref. Awaji Kaori-no Koen Park** (Tel:0799-85-2330) A fragrance-themed park.
- 25 Shizuka no Sato Park** (Tel:0799-62-4731) Shizuka Gozen was famous for her romance with Minamoto-no-Yoshitsune, and as a master of dance. It is said that she lived out her life in this area. There is a tea room and museum with historical records maintained within the park.
- 26 Tako Sembel no Sato** (Tel:0799-60-2248) You can watch the famous Tako Sembel (Octopus Rice Crackers) being made. The crackers are sold directly to the public at the factory.
- 27 Farm-Fresh Produce Awaji Island Akai Yane** (Tel:0799-62-7245) A co-op selling local fruit and vegetables, seafood and other local specialties.
- 28 Awaji World Park Onokoro** (Tel:0799-62-1192) The main attraction is a 'Miniature World Park', which includes many of the world's famous buildings. There is also a miniaturized world cruise visiting many of the world's coastlines and rivers, a 60-meter Ferris wheel with a full view of Osaka bay, numerous rides such as a new grass

- slide ride, a BBQ area that both couples and families can enjoy, and an amusement area for children and adults alike.
- 29 Wellness Park Goshiki and Goshiki Hot Springs** (Yuyu Five) (Tel:0799-33-1600) A 'Wellness' themed park where you can experience 'Wellness'. Amenities include public accommodation, tennis courts and the 'Yuyu Five' Hot Springs.
- 29 Takataya Kahai Park and Takataya Kahai Memorial Hall** (Na no Hana Hall) (Tel:0799-33-0354) A museum for the famous Takataya Kahai who lived during the Edo period (1603-1868). The center has a 1/2 scale Kiamae-bune ship (Edo period cargo ship), and shows a moving documentary of his life on a large screen.
- 30 Kenko Dojo** (Tel:0799-33-0535) The country's first public 'Health Hall', Kenko Dojo has a sports ground and the very popular 'Fasting Hall'.
- 31 Goshikhama Beach** The beach is covered with small sparkling gem-like stones.
- 32 Senzan Senkoji Temple** (Tel:0799-22-0281) The temple is situated 448-meters above sea level, and is Awaji Island's most famous temple. The mountain is affectionately called 'Awaji's Fuji.'
- 33 Itsukushima Shrine** (Tel:0799-22-0049) The shrine is affectionately called 'Benben-sari'
- 34 The Sumoto City Awajishima Museum** (Tel:0799-24-3331) Displaying Awaji history, people, and festivals, the museum is a great way to learn about Awaji Island.
- 35 Mt. Mikuma and Sumoto Castle Site** The castle tower sits on the hill peak at 133-meters above sea level, and is known for its castle wall of rock work.
- 36 Sumoto Hot Springs** You can take a hot spring foot-bath here.
- 37 Narugashima Island and Oishi Park** The bank extends 2 km<sup>2</sup> south into the sea, and is also named the "Awaji Land-Bridge."
- 38 Tachikawa Narcissus Field** (Tel:0799-27-2653) A flower garden with 3 million narcissus.
- 39 Awaji Island Monkey Center** (Tel:0799-29-0345) A monkey park with 180 hand-reared Japanese Monkeys.
- 40 Awaji Fureai Park** (Tel:0799-45-1411) A 180,000m<sup>2</sup> park.
- 41 Tenmei Shishi Monument and Hirota Plum Tree Park** Tenmei Shishi's monument, and the plum forest behind it can be seen here.
- 42Nada Kuroiwa Narcissus Field** (Tel:0799-56-0721) Lying on a 45 degree slope, a 7 hectare field of 5 million wild narcissus flowers from the end of December to February.
- 43 Nushima** Nushima is an island that sits isolated 4.6 km<sup>2</sup> from the Awaji coast, with precipitous cliffs to the south-east and its extraordinary 'kamitategamiwa' rock formations.
- 44 Mt. Yuzuruha** The highest peak on Awaji, at 608 meters.
- 45 Yuzuruha Dam and the Minami Awaji City Cycling Terminal** (Tel:0799-42-5310) Famous for its cherry blossoms, there are also tennis courts there.

- 46 Mihara Hot Springs Sanyu Kan** (Tel:0799-43-9939) An alkaline hot spring bath.
- 47 Naraijiri Temple** View Chinese Junipers over 300 years old.
- 48 Awajishima Ranch** (Tel:0799-42-2066) Experience a ranch with tourist facilities.
- 49 Awaji Farm Park and England Hill** (Tel:0799-43-2626) The 'England' area has a lake and green surroundings. You can experience bread baking and butter making. In the 'Greenhill' area, you can see the biggest rock garden in Asia and the Great Greenhouse, as well as many cute animals including koalas.
- 50 Onokorojima Shrine** (Tel:0799-42-5320) A famous location to become a couple, Onokorojima Shrine also has one of the top three biggest 'Torii' Shrine archways in Japan at 21.7 meters tall.
- 51 Awaji Kokubunji Temple** (Tel:0799-42-4779) Built in the Nara period (710-794AD).
- 52 Birthplace of 'Awaji Ningyō', and the History Museum** (Tel:0799-43-5037) The birthplace of Awaji Puppets, including a display of the Ichimura puppet troupe's tools and props.
- 53 Keino Matsubara** Known nationally for its scenic beauty. Strolling promenades decoratively made of 'Ibushi' tiles, called "Onizuka"(Devil's Mound), and "Proposal Kaido- an avenue where couples propose" are maintained at Keino Matsubara.
- 54 Awaji Tiles "Real Experience"** (Tel:0799-36-2303) Experience real Awaji tile making.
- 55 Gyokuseikan and Kokuseizenji Temple** (Tel:0799-36-2314 or 0799-36-5223) A museum with artist Jikihara Gyokusei's Southern school of (Chinese style) paintings on display.
- 56 Otsubonezuka** The grave of Tairano Michimori's first wife.
- 57 Navy Training Facility, Monument to the Dead and Kannon, Goddess of Mercy**
- 58 Uzushio Hot Springs** (Uzushio Onsen) (Tel:0799-36-5789) An excellent healing hot springs, also called "Bijin no Yu" (makes women beautiful).
- 59 Michi no Eki Uzushio** (Narutomisaki House) (Tel:0799-52-1157) You can eat at the center while viewing the nearby Great Naruto Bridge and the Naruto Whirlpools.
- 60 Uzu no Oka, the Great Naruto Bridge Memorial Museum and the Whirlpool Science Center** (Tel:0799-52-2888) Experience the mysteries and excitement of the Naruto Whirlpools.
- 60 Uzu no Oka, the Awaji Puppet Theater** (Tel:0799-52-0260) Enjoy an Awaji Puppet stage performance.
- 61 The Uzushio Observation Boat** (Kanrimaru)(Tel:0799-52-0054)(Marino Port Ibi)(Tel:0799-39-0201) Tourist boats departing from the Awaji Island side of the Naruto Whirlpools.
- 62 Minamiawaji City Onsenkyo Nandan Hot Springs** Enjoy a 'low-sodium' hot spring bath.
